COVID-19 Health and Safety Plan

Firetree Place has the following health and safety guidelines in place for Summer Camp 2020.

- All youth and staff will have their temperature taken upon entering facility
 - If temperature is 100.4 or higher, they will be asked to leave and not return for two weeks
 - If temperature is 99.5 – 100.3, we will continue to monitor the child's temperature throughout the day
- All youth and staff will wear masks during the day
 - Youth will not wear masks during mealtime and recreation
 - Staff will not wear masks during mealtime and if they are actively participating in recreation
- Upon drop off, parents and guardians will be asked the following questions.
 - 1) Over the past two weeks, have you, your child, or anyone else in your house been in contact with a diagnosed case of COVID-19?
 - 2) Has your child developed a fever or a new cough?
- If any staff or youth have been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19, they will not be able to return for two weeks
- If any staff or youth in the facility are diagnosed with COVID-19, the facility will close for two weeks
- Only staff and youth are permitted inside of the facility
- Hands must be washed upon entering the building
- Hands must be washed after each activity
- Tables, chairs, toys, etc. will be sanitized with a bleach solution between activities
- Tables, chairs, toys, etc. will be washed with soapy water and then sanitized with a bleach solution at the end of the day
- Bathrooms will be washed with soapy water and then sanitized with a bleach solution
- Social distancing will be practiced with youth and staff
- Field trips are cancelled and camp is on site
- Youth will have their own water bottles and will not use the water fountain
- Camp days are 9am-3pm to allow more time for cleaning during the morning and afternoon
